
# **GENERAL FEATURES**

# WIRING CONNECTIONS


■ Color: 1.white 2.red 3.blue 4.yellow

**Notice:** Socket CN5 is just retained for outdoor station in alone villa system (like as one outdoor unit is matched with one indoor unit), please recheck carefully the polarity of CN5 and have the 4-wire connected as per the enclosed label.

# **OPERATION OF THE SYSTEM**



#### NO CALL. Indoor Monitor On Stand-by

If the monitor does not receive a call, the functions of UNLOCK and TALK with the outdoor station are disabled. It is possible to monitor the street by pushing MONITOR  $(\Bar{N})$  button.

#### RECEIVING A CALL, Indoor Monitor Activated

- 1.An audio signal from the indoor monitor will be heard when a call is received from outdoor station. Following the screen will switch on and show the image of the person who has called.
- \* If no other buttons are pressed the monitor will shut off after 60 seconds.

  2. When the TALK ( ) button is pressed, communication is established with
- 2. When the TALK ((S)) button is pressed, communication is established wit the person who is calling.
- \*The conversation time is limited to 120 seconds. The conversation will end when the communication button is pressed once, or when the conversation time runs out. The system will then revert to being on standby.
- 3.Push the corresponding button to open the door (), and allow the person access to the house.

#### **SEVERAL MONITORS IN YOUR HOUSE**

- 1. The call rings on all the monitors. The first person to answer establishes communication with the visitor.
- 2.Intercom Call

If there are several monitors in the dwelling, it is possible to make an internal intercom call

To do this, while the system is on standby press the Call-forward button (③) of one of the monitors: all the other monitors will emit DINGDONG sounds. The call is answered by pressing the TALK on one of the other monitors. There is 60 seconds to answer the inner calling.

3. Call-forward Function

Press Call-forward ( ) button to forward the call to other indoor monitors. When you press this button during the intercom, the other indoor monitors (if have) will ring and pop up the image of outside visitor.

#### **ADJUSTMENT OPTIONS**

- 1.Adjusting The Volume
  Turn the VOLUME CONTROL knob(♥) to regulate the volume which will be heard by the person at the indoor monitor.
- 2.Adjusting The Chroma/Contrast AND Brightness Of The Image The characteristics of brightness and contrast of the image can be adjusted from the monitor.

To do so, simply adjust the controls (☼) and (ℰ)) of the monitor.

#### MONITOR EXTRA CCTV CAMERA

If connect two CCTV cameras, press the Monitor Button( A) once to see the outdoor station; press again, the #1 CCTV camera; the third pressing, #2 CCTV camera. The same operation on the other monitors.

# **OPERATION OF A4-D0108**

- Default Setting: The mini jumper is on the Pin1 and Pin2 of J6.
  - There is three ID cards in the package, one is Add Card, one is Delete Card, and another is User Card.

NOTE: If the mini jumper's position is going to be changed during the setting, please remember to disconnect the power supply of the outdoor station first (for about 10 seconds), and after re-connecting the power you can go to the setting mode.


If no need to alter the mini jumper's position, then do not need to cut the power.

#### 1.Add User Card

Make sure that the mini jumper is on the Pin1 and Pin2 of J6.

First swipe the Add Card on the card-reading area, and "Bl~Bl~~~" sound release; Then swipe an ID card, 2 beeps release; Now, this ID card is successfully set as an User Card

Swipe the Delete Card again to exit the setting, 3 beeps come out.



#### 2.Delete User Card

Make sure that the mini jumper is on the Pin1 and Pin2 of J6.

First swipe the Delete Card on the card-reading area, and "BI~BI~~~" sound release; Then swipe the user card which you want to delete, and 2 beeps release; Now, this User Card is successfully deleted.

Swipe the Delete Card again to exit the setting, 3 beeps come out.

#### 3.Add Batching User Cards

Make sure that the mini jumper is on the Pin1 and Pin2 of J6.

First swipe the Add Card on the card-reading area, and "BI~BI~~~" sound release; Then swipe the ID cards which you want to set as User Cards one after another. Each time you swipe the card, 2 beeps release; Then, these ID cards are successfully set as User Cards.

And end the setting by swipe the Add Card again, 3 beeps come out.

#### 4.Delete Batching User Cards

Make sure that the mini jumper is on the Pin1 and Pin2 of J6.

#### ①Delete a few cards

Swipe the Delete Card on the card-reading area, and "BI~BI~~~" sound release, then swipe the User Cards which you want to delete one after another. Each time you swipe the card, 2 beeps release, then these User Cards are successfully deleted.


And end the setting by swipe the Delete Card again, 3 beeps come out.

#### 2 Delete all the user cards

Swipe the Delete Card on the card-reading area, and "BI~BI~~~" sound release, then swipe the Add Card, beeps will last for about 10 seconds, then all the user cards will be delete and exit the setting automatically.

#### 5.Setting the Unlock Timer

First, please open the rear cover of the outdoor station, as following picture shows.



And as previous mentioned, please disconnect the power supply, and reconnect the power after around 10 seconds.

When you put the mini jumper on the Pin1 and Pin2 of J5, the unlock delay time is 1 second;

When put the mini jumper on the Pin2 and Pin3 of J5, the unlock delay time is 10 seconds.

#### 6.Set the Master Cards

There are two Master Cards, one is *Add Card*, the other one is *Delete Card*.

Usually, they are packed in the accessory bag. But if you lost or break them, you can following the below instructions to set them yourself.

First, please open the rear cover of the outdoor station, as the previous point shows. And the same as previous mentioned, please disconnect the power supply, and reconnect the power after around 10 seconds.

Please prepare two ID cards:

Then put the mini jumper on the Pin2 and Pin3 of J6;

Swipe one card on the card-reading area, then comes with two beeps "BI~ BI~~~", indicating successful *Add Card* setting:

And then swipe the other card, and the same "BI~ BI~~~" sound release, indicating **Delete Card** set successfully.


Kindly remind, please mark the two cards with tags so that you can still tell which is Add Card, which is Delete Card next time.

# **INSTALLATION PROCESS**

#### INSTRUCTION:


- (1), Cable Requirement: 1 non-stp core cable
  - ② wire  $\geq 0.5$ mm from outdoor station to the farthest monitor  $\leq 70$ m
- (2). The system can support at most 4 indoor monitors and 2 out-door stations.
- (3), Each video door phone should be with a power supply of 14.3 V, 1A.
- (4), CCTV current requirement:working ≤ 500mA




#### ■ A4-R0702TJ INSTALLATION DIAGRAM SKETCH










#### ■ A4-D0103 INSTALLATION DIAGRAM SKETCH




